Hyder Family Hospice House opened in 2007 to meet the need for inpatient hospice care for those in our communities. Seven years later, on September 5, 2014, the doors closed due to financial challenges faced by the owner at the time.

In July 2015, Strafford County obtained licensing and state approval to reopen Hyder Family Hospice House as a Hospice Unit of Riverside Rest Home, Dover, NH. It remains in full operation today, providing love, care and support to all its guests and their families.
